

Chamber Displays Armored Products

ROCKVILLE (Special) — A display of some 5 items manufactured by Acromold Products of 95 Brooklyn St. has attracted much attention in the windows of the Rockville Area Chamber of Commerce on East Main Street.

Acromold Products Corp. was started in 1960 by Donald Pelham and Clifford Hawley in custom plastic injection molding for such companies as Stanley Works, Westinghouse, Milton Bradley and Wico Electric.

In 1962 Acromold purchased the Triangle Manufacturing Co., also in Rockville, and the three principals are now Pelham, Harry Zashut and Hawley.

The company is continuing to expand. With the advent of redevelopment, they will have to leave their present premises, but hope to relocate in the immediate area.

The next display in the chamber window will feature the products of the Tober Baseball Co., also on Brooklyn Street.
