Alphonzo Eugene Pelham died Wednesday at his home, 22 Meadow Lane, New Rochelle, aged 71. He was the founder of the Pelham Operating Company, which supplied temporary hoists for construction work on New York buildings. His father, Thomas M. Pelham, is said to have been the original patentee in 1868 of safety hoists for this purpose.
